
Do you not know that all of us who have been bap-tized in-to Christ Je-sus were bap-tized in -




to his death? ⁴ Therefore we have been buried with him by bap-tism in-to death, so that, just




as Christ was raised from the dead by the glo-ry of the Fa-ther, so we too might walk in new -




ness of life. ⁵ For if we have been u-nit-ed with him in a death like his, we will certainly be u -




nited with him in a resur-rec-tion like his. ⁶ We know that our old self was crucified with him




so that the bod-y of sin might be de-stroyed, and we might no lon-ger be en-slaved to sin. ⁷ For




whoever has died is freed from sin. ⁸ But if we have died with Christ, we believe that we will




al-so live with him. ⁹ We know that Christ, being raised from the dead, will nev-er die a-gain;




death no longer has do-min-ion o- ver him. ¹⁰ The death he died, he died to sin, once for all;
