
and he showed himself in this way. ² Gathered there together were Simon Peter, Thomas called



the Twin, Nathanael of Cana in Galilee, the sons of Zebedee, and two others of his dis-ci-ples.




³ Simon Peter said to them, “I am going fish-ing.” They said to him, “We will go with you.”




They went out and got into the boat, but that night they caught noth-ing.








“No.” ⁶ He said to them, “Cast the net to the right side of the boat, and you will find some.”



So they cast it, and now they were not a - ble to haul it in because there were so man-y




fish. ⁷ That disciple whom Jesus loved said to Peter, “It is the Lord!” When Simon Peter heard




that it was the Lord, he put on some clothes, for he was na - ked, and jumped into the sea. ⁸




But the other dis - ci - ples came in the boat, drag-ging the net full of fish, for they were not




far from the land, only about a hundred yards off.




⁹ When they had gone ashore, they saw a char-coal fire there, with fish on it, and bread. ¹⁰




Jesus said to them, “Bring some of the fish that you have just caught.” ¹¹ So Simon Peter went



a-board and hauled the net a-shore, full of large fish, a hundred fifty-three of them; and though




there were so man-y, the net was not torn. ¹² Jesus said to them, “Come and have break-fast.”
