



Epiphany 4 (Year B, RCL) — Mark 1:21-28 (NRSV)




✠ The Holy Gospel of our Lord Je-sus Christ ac-cord-ing to Mark. ✠ *Glo-ry to you, Lord Christ.*



Je-sus and his dis-ci-ples went to Ca-per-na-um; and when the sabbath came, he entered the synagogue




and taught. 22 They were as-tound-ed at his teach-ing, for he taught them as one having authority, and




not as the scribes. 23 Just then there was in their synagogue a man with an un-clean spir-it, 24 and he




cried out, “What have you to do with us, Je-sus of Na-za-reth? Have you come to de-stroy us? I know




who you are, the Ho-ly One of God.” 25 But Je-sus re-buked him, say- ing, “Be silent, and come




out of him!” 26 And the unclean spirit, con-vul-sing him and cry-ing with a loud voice, came out of
