



Epiphany 5 (Year B, RCL) — Mark 1:29-39 (NRSV)




✠ The Holy Gospel of our Lord Je-sus Christ ac-cord-ing to Mark. ✠ *Glo-ry to you, Lord Christ.*




Jesus left the synagogue at Capernaum and entered the house of Si-mon and An-drew, with James and John. **30** Now

the hand and lifted her up. Then the fe-ver left her, and she began to serve them. **32** That evening, at sundown, they




brought to him all who were sick or possessed with de-mons. **33** And the whole city was gathered around the door. **34**




And he cured many who were sick with var-i-ous dis-eas-es, and cast out man-y de-mons; and he would not permit




the demons to speak, be-cause they knew him. **35** In the morn-ing, while it was still ver-y dark, he got up and went




out to a de- sert-ed place, and there he prayed. **36** And Simon and his companions hunt-ed for him. **37** When they
