


Last Sunday after Epiphany (Year B, RCL)




✠ The Holy Gospel of our Lord Je-sus Christ ac-cord-ing to Mark. ✠ *Glo-ry to you, Lord Christ.*



Six days later, Jesus took with him Peter and James and John, and led them up a high mountain apart,




by them-selves. And he was trans-fig-ured be-fore them, ³ and his clothes be-came daz-zling white, such




as no one on earth could bleach them. ⁴ And there ap-peared to them E - li - jah with Mo-ses, who were




talk-ing with Je-sus. ⁵ Then Peter said to Jesus, “Rab-bi, it is good for us to be here; let us make three




dwel-ings, one for you, one for Moses, and one for E-li-jah.” ⁶ He did not know what to say, for they




were ter-ri-fied. ⁷ Then a cloud o-ver-shad-owed them, and from the cloud there came a voice, “This
