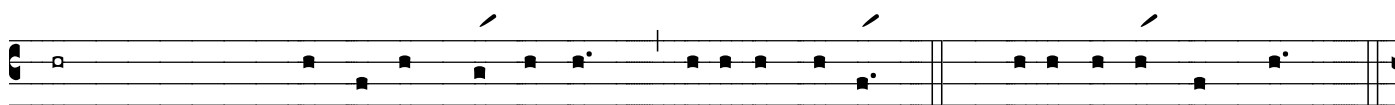


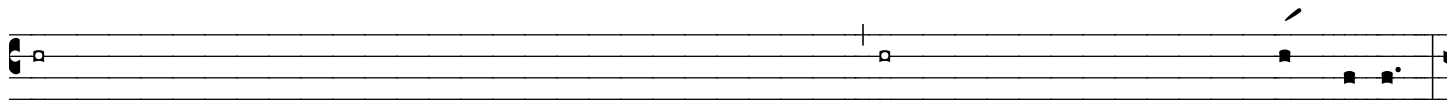
Holy Name (Jan. 1, ABC RCL) — Luke 2:15-21 (NRSV)



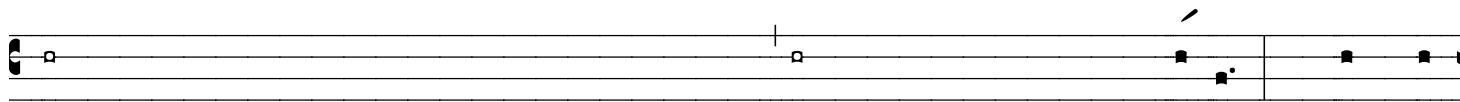

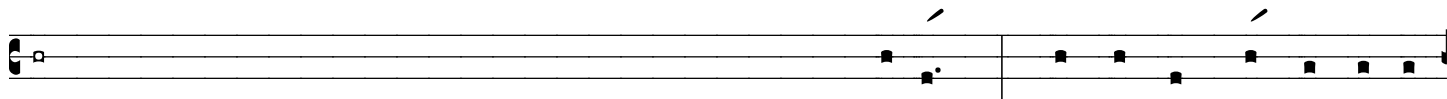
When the angels had left them and gone in-to heav-en, the shep-herds said to one an-oth-er, “Let us



go now to Bethlehem and see this thing that has taken place, which the Lord has made known to us.”



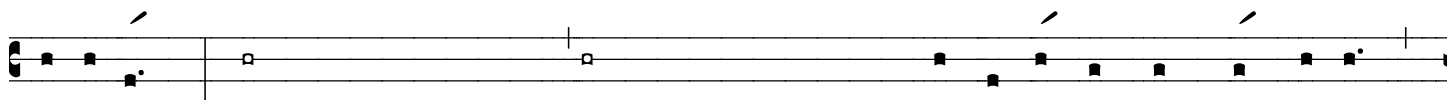
16 So they went with haste and found Mary and Joseph, and the child lying in the man-ger. 17 When they



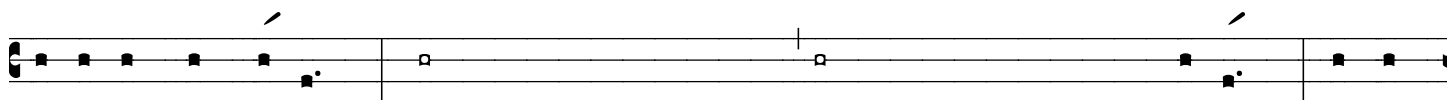
saw this, they made known what had been told them about this child; 18 and all who heard it were a-



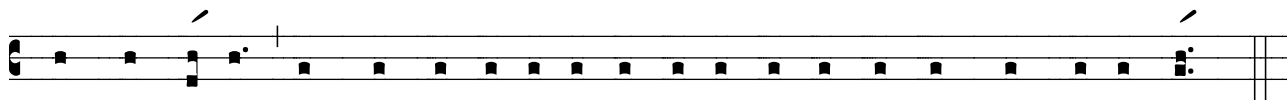
mazed at what the shep-herds told them. 19 But Mar-y treas-ured all these words and pon-dered them



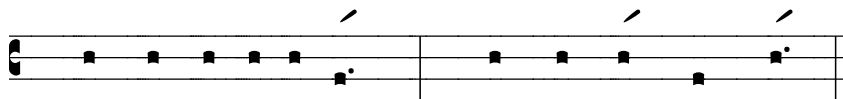
in her heart. 20 The shepherds returned, glorifying and praising God for all they had heard and seen,
