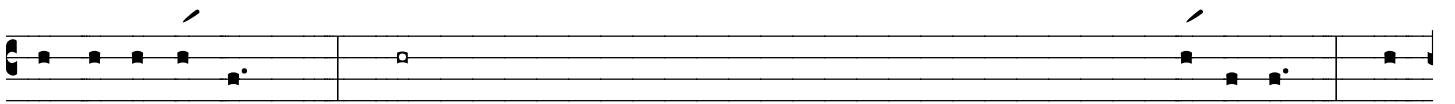
In those days Jesus came from Na-za-reth of Ga-li-lee and was baptized by John in the Jor-dan. **10**



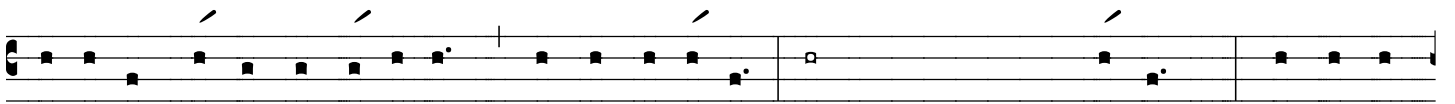
And just as he was com-ing up out of the wa-ter, he saw the heav-ens torn apart and the Spirit de-



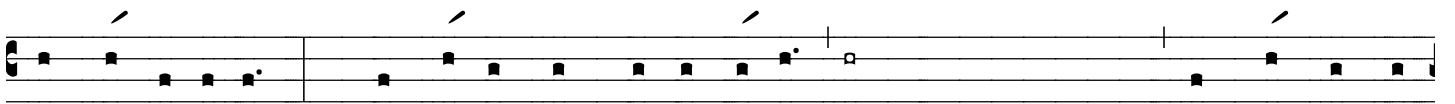
scending like a dove on him. **11** And a voice came from heav-en, “You are my Son, the Beloved; with



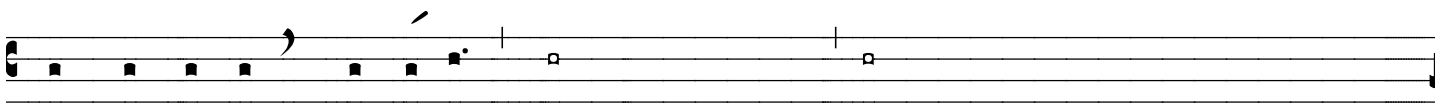
you I am well pleased.” **12** And the Spirit immediately drove him out into the wild-er-ness. **13** He



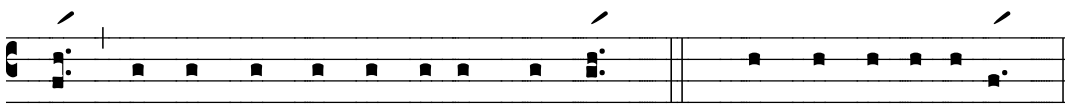
was in the wild-er-ness for-ty days, temp-ted by Sa-tan; and he was with the wild beasts; and the an-
