
Now before the festival of the Passover, Jesus knew that his hour had come to depart from this




world and go to the Fa-ther. Hav-ing loved his own who were in the world, he loved them to




the end. The devil had already put it into the heart of Judas son of Simon Iscariot to be-tray him.



And during supper Jesus, knowing that the Father had given all things into his hands, and that he




had come from God and was go-ing to God, got up from the table, took off his outer robe, and




tied a towel a-round him. He came to Simon Peter, who said to him, "Lord, are you go-ing to wash




my feet?" Jesus answered, "You do not know now what I am do-ing, but later you will un-der-




stand.” Peter said to him, “You will never wash my feet.” Jesus answered, “Unless I wash you,




you have no share with me.” Simon Peter said to him, “Lord, not my feet only but also my hands




and my head!” Jesus said to him, “One who has bathed does not need to wash, except for the




feet, but is en-tire-ly clean. And you are clean, though not all of you.” For he knew who was to




be-tray him; for this reason he said, “Not all of you are clean.” After he had washed their feet,




had put on his robe, and had returned to the table, he said to them, “Do you know what I have done




to you? You call me Teacher and Lord — and you are right, for that is what I am. So if I,




your Lord and Teacher, have washed your feet, you also ought to wash one an-oth-er’s feet. For




I have set you an ex-am-ple, that you also should do as I have done to you. Very truly, I tell




you, ser-vants are not great-er than their mas-ter, nor are messengers greater than the one who



sent them. If you know these things, you are blessed if you do them....When he had gone out,




Jesus said, "Now the Son of Man has been glo-ri-fied, and God has been glorified in him. If




God has been glorified in him, God will also glorify him in himself and will glorify him at once.
