






Jesus and his disciples came to Jer - i - cho. As they and a large crowd were leav - ing




Jer- i - cho, Bartimaeus son of Timaues, a blind beggar, was sitting by the road-side.




47 When he heard that it was Jesus of Nazareth, he be - gan to shout out and say, “Je -




sus, Son of David, have mer - cy on me!” 48 Many sternly ordered him to be quiet,




but he cried out e - ven more loud - ly, “Son of David, have mer - cy on me!” 49




Jesus stood still and said, “Call him here.” And they called the blind man, say - ing




to him, “Take heart; get up, he is cal - ling you.” 50 So throw - ing off his cloak,




he sprang up and came to Je - sus. 51 Then Jesus said to him, “What do you want




me to do for you?” The blind man said to him, “My teach-er, let me see a - gain.”
