

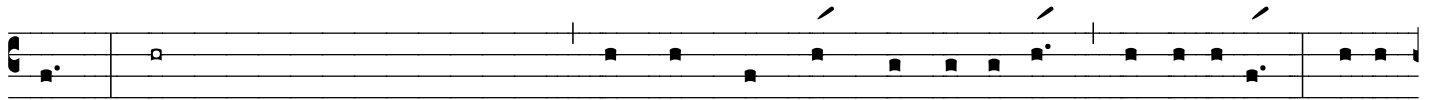
Mark 4:35-41 (Year B, Proper 7) (NRSV)

side.” 36 And leaving the crowd behind, they took him with them in the boat, just as he was. Oth-er



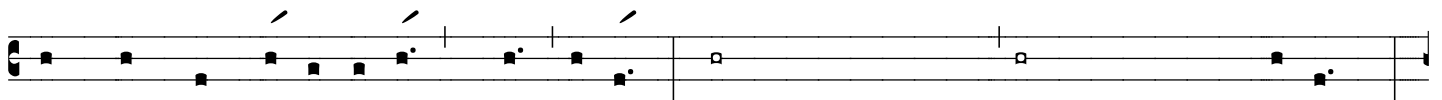
boats were with him. 37 A great wind-storm a-rose, and the waves beat into the boat, so that the boat



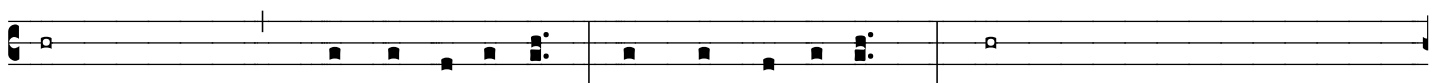
was already be-ing swamped. 38 But he was in the stern, asleep on the cush-ion; and they woke him



up and said to him, “Teach-er, do you not care that we are per-ish-ing?” 39 He woke up and rebuked



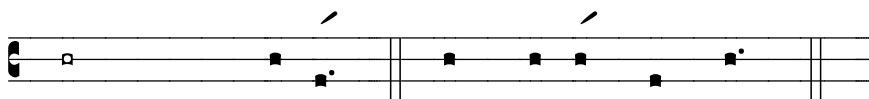
the wind, and said to the sea, “Peace! Be still!” Then the wind ceased, and there was a dead calm. 40
