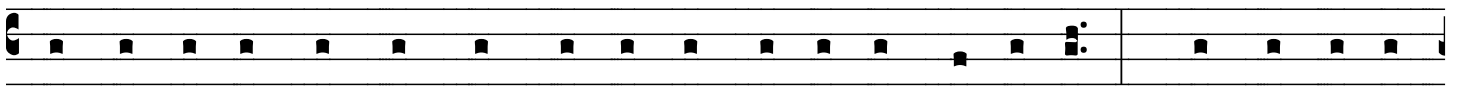
Jesus came to his hometown and be-gan to teach the peo-ple in their syn - a-gogue, so



that they were as-tound-ed and said, “Where did this man get this wis-dom and these



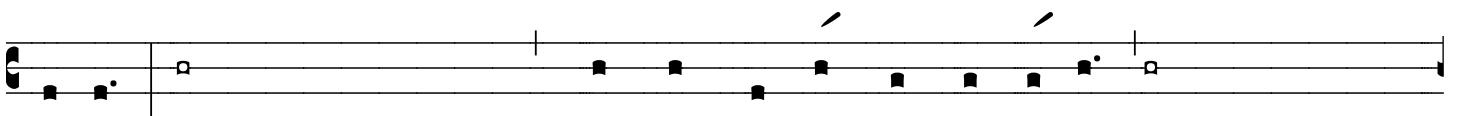
deeds of pow-er? 55 Is not this the car-pen-ter’s son? Is not his moth-er called Mar-y?



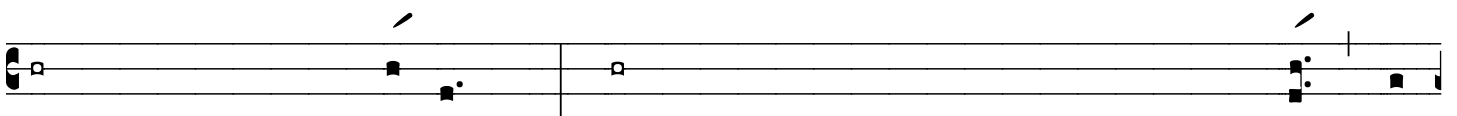
And are not his broth-ers James and Jo-seph and Si-mon and Ju-das? 56 And are not all



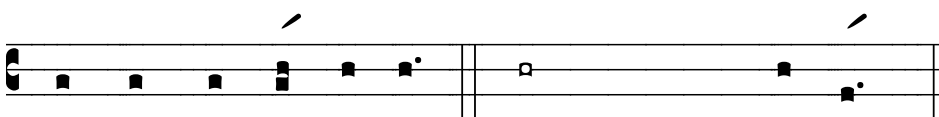
his sis - ters with us? Where then did this man get all this?” 57 And they took of - fense
